The Programme

Training, discipleship and encouragement to:
 Kasese Church and Prison ministry
 Ssese Islands
 St Marks Church Entebbe Certificate Ceremony
 Kasilso Parish Church consisting of 8 Churches
 Visit to Perez in Mbarara region
 Luweero Church Tutor training



Challenges for the rest of the year

Commitment to St Mark's Cathedral, Luweero for Sean training workshop for 50 students to be enrolled
 Commitment to Namirembe Diocese - Masulita Church to include a further 3 churches for training
 Commitment to Kampala Diocese Education pioneer group training to 5 churches to set as a role model for a further 5 churches that will have up to 500 people in each congregation and 3 different services
 Commitment to a Parish that has 13 churches that have asked for training with minimum 350 people in these churches
 Commitment to a further 4 Islands on Ssese in October and encouragement and support to the other Islands
 Provide Life to the Full and Pure Gold books in Luganda and English to all these people in addition to the other needs

The Project

Project Managed the building work including:
 Cleared the land
 Installed culverts
 Built the Managers house and office to first floor level
 Built the Medical centre to half height level
 Cleared the land for the Community Centre and guest house.



Challenges for the rest of the year

Raise funds to finish the Managers house and office including roof and internal work ready for habitation
 Raise funds to finish the Medical Centre including the roof, internal work and equipment
 Raise funds to build the Community/Training Centre and guest house

Rob Said "It is so very exciting to be part of this absolute miracle taking place." I asked him what the "white stuff was" and his reply.... "The white stuff is called waffles, they are concrete slabs that come with a shape underneath that forms the ceiling below, the iron cages are out there to hold the structure in place and make it strong, the iron bars on top of the waffles are to reinforce the concrete that will be laid, we are ready to install the electrical conducts (that's the black small pipes on top) ready to run the power cables and the grey plastic pipes for water in and drainage out.
